
For Food Vendors

The Southwest Utah Public Health Department will be requiring all temporary food service vendors to have a valid temporary food service permit from the health department. The fee is \$50 for a valid 2-3 consecutive day permit.

Food Vendors are responsible for obtaining the permits from the Health Department. Contact Clint Albrecht of the Southwest Utah Health Department at calbrecht@swuhealth.org or call 435-676-8800. You can also find the permit application on swuhealth.org.

For purposes of public safety, NO EARLY BOOTH TEAR DOWN will be permitted. TEAR DOWN is scheduled AFTER 6 PM SATURDAY AUGUST 26th. (Weather Permitting)

Electric fees are based on use. Prices are a per outlet fee. (\$25 for up to a 15 amp plug and \$50 for up to a 30-amp plug)
For additional needs, prior approval from the electrical staff is required.

Free live entertainment will be provided on stages until 7:00pm each evening

CHECK, MONEY ORDER AND CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED FOR FEES

If space permits late applications may be accepted.

FEES

- All booth fees due with application. They will be refunded if your booth is not chosen.
- Booth fee is \$175 for an Art and/or Craft booth (If vendor plans on selling any food or beverage in their art and craft booth, they must pay the food and beverage booth fee).
- Booth fee is \$200 for a Food and Beverage booth.
- Electricity is available on a limited basis for a fee of \$25, one 110 outlet only. Additional outlets will add an additional charge. Silent generators may be used upon approval from the coordinator. No phone or wireless internet available.
- Each participant will be assigned a tax collection # from the Utah State Tax Commission and participants will be responsible for collecting and remitting tax during the event. The Kanab tax rate is 7.95%. A Tax ID will be assigned at check -in.

BOOTH INFORMATION

- 10' x 10' booth space.
- Participants will provide their own canopies tents, tables, chairs, displays and extension cords. Outlets may be several feet away and not at your booth site. Cords need to be taped down thru common walkways.
- The festival will take place rain or shine.
- Set-up will be on pavement - bring weights, no stakes. Participant is responsible for securing any items/coverings associated with their booth space.
- Participants are responsible for the safety and security of their own belongings during the event and Cleanup of ALL TRASH. A cleanup fee will be charged from \$100-\$500 if sites are not left clean and face losing next year's booth space.
- Limited security patrols will be provided on the nights of August 25-26 at the festival location. Western Legends is not liable for stolen items.
- Food Vendors must provide their own tents, are responsible for the food vending area and for cleanup of ALL food vending TRASH- A clean up fee will be charged from \$100-\$500 if sites are not left clean, and face losing next year's booth space.
- Like vendors will be kept to a minimum, but will be allowed

Only true western arts and handcrafts will be accepted, unless otherwise approved

We encourage all vendors to be in western wear.

- Booth spaces will be assigned. You will not receive your booth assignment until check-in. **Check-in times are Thursday, August 24th 6-9PM and Friday August 25th 6-7AM. All vehicles must be out of street vendor area by 8:45am August 25th.**
- Booth Confirmation and receipt will be mailed after applications are reviewed, and received, if you do not receive conformation please call the Western Legends Office
